

Biography Staf C. van Cauter, MSc., MBA



Mr. van Cauter is Executive Director at medical imaging innovation company, MILabs B.V., Utrecht, the Netherlands.

Prior to joining MILabs, he was Director and Executive Vice-President at Trifoil Imaging and Directeur Général at Bio Molecular Imaging France. Until the acquisition of Bioscan Inc. by Trifoil Imaging in 2013, Mr. van Cauter was Chairman, President and CEO of Bioscan, and before joining Bioscan in 2004, he was Corporate Vice-President Marketing & Sales and Chief Technology Officer of Packard BioScience Company. After the acquisition of Packard BioScience by PerkinElmer, Inc in 2001, he served as Corporate Vice-President and Strategic Consultant to PerkinElmer from 2001 until 2003 and formulated a strategic plan for this company to enter the preclinical imaging market.

He holds a Masters Degree of Science in Industrial Engineering and Biochemistry from the Higher Institute for Technology in Mechelen-Leuven, Belgium and completed post-graduate studies in business administration at the Universities of London and Chicago. He resides in the US since 1985, currently Yale University, New Haven, Connecticut.

Mr. van Cauter has been responsible for many first-time market introductions of molecular imaging systems including the introduction of storage phosphor imaging for clinical and preclinical radiography, the first commercialization of multiplexed multi-pinhole SPECT in 2004, the first-to-market 3D tomographic Optical Imager in 2013, the introduction of the first 3.0T/7.0T integrated preclinical PET/MRI system in 2014, and the commercialization of hexamodal radiomics imaging of tumors in 2016.
